



RECIPIENT ELIGIBILITY

Assistance shall be provided based on family/individual needs determined after review by the Carroll Brothers Charitable Fund Review Committee. To be eligible for financial assistance from the Carroll Brothers Charitable Fund, an individual or family must meet all of the requirements of the below Eligibility

- Preferences will be given to Individuals/Families who reside or have resided within the local area of the foundation.
- Individual/Family must provide documents showing financial hardship due to medical expenses, natural disaster or fire.
- Individual/Family must not have received financial aid from the charity in the past 12 months.
- Individual/Family is presently being treated or recently completed treatment for cancer or other devastating disease or is recovering from a natural disaster or fire, as determined by the Review Committee
- Individual/Family must use funds for essential needs only, such as (but not limited to):
 - Rent/Mortgage
 - Childcare
 - Utilities
 - Food
 - Medical Bills
 - Transportation

Documents must be provided. A photocopy of Illinois Driver's License or State ID. A parent or guardian must submit a photocopy of their Illinois Driver's License. The recipient must not be related by blood or marriage to any board members.
